2016 cohort initial destinations data: Our own data shows that the following % went to these destinations at the start of September 2016 (i.e. Initial destinations, not yet eligible to count as 'sustained'):

99% started further education or employment

100% of disadvantaged pupils started further education or employment

Of this 99%, 50% went to an FE college, 37% went to a sixth form college, 6% apprenticeships, 6% other (including a number of overseas sports scholarships). 1 student is currently NEET.

Key Stage 5 (A level) results

The unvalidated data release from the DfE in September 2016 shows that:

Progress measure for academic value added = -0.39

Average points score per academic entry expressed as an A level grade = C-

Progress measure for vocational (general applied) value added = +0.02

Average points score per applied general entry expressed as a vocational grade = Dist+

Progress made by students in English and maths in GCSE resits = unreported (only one student was eligible for this measure, so reporting would be directly identifiable to this student)
