Y8 Humanities Trip to The Science Museum, London – Thursday 6th February 2025

An exciting opportunity has arisen to take Year 8 pupils to the Science Museum on Thursday 6th February 2024. The visit will provide the opportunity to see the world-renowned Science Museum in South Kensington, London. Pupils can explore the museum and have a go at the hands-on exhibits as part of this visit. This will complement the Year 8 Geography curriculum and other Humanities content studied over their time in Key Stage 3.

As part of this trip, we have secured booking to additional events in the time we are at the Science Museum. We will be attending an Imax 3D experience titled 'Antarctica', this will give us a fascinating chance to explore the continent.

Additionally, we will be going to an interactive exhibition called 'Power Up', this will focus on problem-solving skills, encourage collaboration and sharpen critical thinking in our hands-on gaming zone.

The coach will leave school at 8.15am and will return at approximately 6.00pm. The cost of this visit including insurance and transport will be £35.00 per person and will be available to book on ParentPay at 3pm on Friday 29th November. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If additional financial support is required, please get in contact as we may be able to help. Pupils should bring a packed lunch as food and drink (plastic bottle) can be very expensive within the museum.

Pupils do not need to wear school uniform but should be smartly dressed and will need comfortable soft soled shoes. Work sheets will be provided and pupils need to bring a pen. Mobile phones may be taken on the trip and used appropriately

Please be aware that should your child withdraw from the trip at any stage before departure, and a replacement cannot be found, that payment will be non refundable. A poor behaviour record may result in a pupil's removal from the trip, and again this will render the trip non refundable.
