Registering on the Website

Website

You may receive an invitation from your child's school which will contain instructions for you to follow. If you don't receive an invite, then you can register yourself by following these instructions:

1. Go to epraise.co.uk
2. Select **Log in** in the top right corner
3. Select the correct school
4. Select the **Parent** tab
5. Enter the email address you gave to the school (leave the password blank)
6. Select **Login/Register**
7. Follow the instructions in the email that is sent to you

App

To register on our iOS or Android app you can:

1. Download our app (just search for Epraise in your app store) and open it
2. Select your school
3. Tap the **Register**
4. Enter the email address that has already been given to the school
5. Tap **Request login code**
6. Enter the login code sent via email
7. Tap **Login**

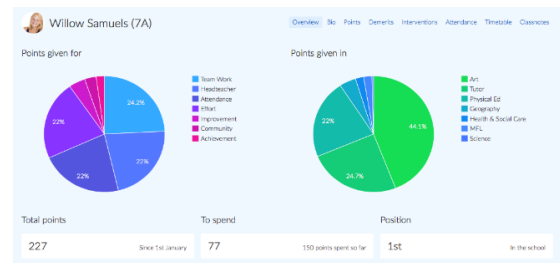
App

On our website, you can view your child/children's profiles under the **My children** tab. On our app, they are listed as tabs on the main screen.

Here you can see how they are doing in school, in areas such as achievement, behaviour, interventions attendance and so on.

On their Bio page, your child has the opportunity to write a profile about themselves, their interests, experiences and achievements.

You can also see their timetable, and classnotes that have been shared with them by their teachers.

Here you can view all your child's/children's homework and notes set by their teachers. On our website, you can find this under **My Children > Planner** and on our app you can find this under the **More** menu for each child.

There is a handy colour coded key to let your know whether your child's work is due, overdue, complete or feedback available.

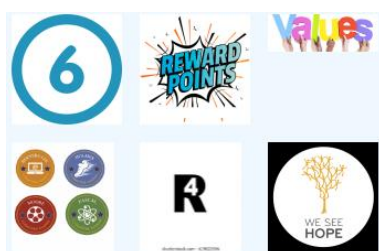
Lydiard Park Academy - ParentPay Activation Information

As you know Lydiard Park Academy is now completely cashless and all school meals, school trips and events must be paid for online using a very secure website called ParentPay.

Please activate your account asap to allow your child to use the cashless catering system from the beginning of the new school year. If you have not yet consented on the blue registration form, please email ask@lydiardparkacademy.org.uk as this is also vital to enable your child to use cashless catering.

Pupils will write about their success against the challenges presented in the booklet. In the PDP (1:1 meetings), the tutor will discuss their achievements and sign off the challenges they complete.

Pupils will be set new challenges against the criteria in TPAT Character Award. They will set a timeframe for review. They can then go ahead and try to achieve the bronze award level. This award will run from year 7 all the way through to year 11.

PDPs will check *interim* progress; we also encourage parents to fully engage with their character development learning journey.
