

Dear Parent / Guardian,

We would like to remind you of the high standard of personal appearance expected of all pupils who attend Lydiard Park Academy. Anyone arriving at school in non-uniform clothing, will be issued with a C3 for incorrect uniform. Non-school uniform items will be removed as will non-uniform jewellery, including any facial piercings.

We ask for your support in encouraging pupils to wait to have facial piercings done over the long holidays or once they have left school and to support them to wear the correct uniform to school. If there is an issue with uniform please send your child in with a note and the date of when you will be able to replace the non-school uniform items. Below is a clear outline of our expectations around the LPA uniform.

School Dress Code

Blazer – contains the LPA badge and worn at all times to, from and around the school. When entering a classroom, the blazer may be removed and hung up or over a chair.	Tie – an LPA tie must be worn at all times to, from and around the school. Top buttons on shirts must be done up.	Jumper – these are optional, but if worn, they must be blue, V-neck jumpers with the LPA badge.	Shirt – must be white, either long or short sleeve.
Coats and Hats – a plain outdoor coat without large logos or writing. Denim, sweatshirts, hoodies and cardigans are not permitted. All coats must be removed when entering a classroom. Hats are not to be worn in any building.	Jewellery - earrings are allowed but should be small and discreet. A single discreet nose stud is also permitted. No other forms of facial/body piercings are allowed. If a pupil has any other piercings, removal will be expected immediately. There are no exceptions to this rule. Pupils are allowed a single watch and one ring on_each hand. No other jewellery is permitted.	Make-up — discreet make-up only. Nail polish and acrylic nails are not permitted at the school due to health and safety protocols in various subjects. Long eye lash extensions are not permitted	Hair – styles should be practical, clean and safe. Extreme hairstyles that detract from the smart appearance of the uniform are not allowed. The definition of what is extreme will change with fashion, but includes partshaven, Mohicans, extreme colours other than natural, patterns cut into or artificial hair extensions.

They must be loose fitting and easily pulled up over the knee.




