

Year 10/11: Creative iMedia (Level 1/2)

Structure of the course:

The Cambridge Nationals Creative iMedia course is composed of 4 units:

- **R081:** Pre-Production Skills (Written examination worth 25%).
- **R082:** Creating digital graphics (Compulsory coursework unit, externally examined worth 25%).

The below is the current selected optional units (may change in the future):

- **R084:** Creating a comic strip (Coursework unit, externally examined worth 25%).
- **R087:** Creating interactive multimedia products (Coursework unit, externally examined worth 25%).

What we will cover in year 10

In year 10 students will complete two of the above units. The year will start with a coursework unit giving students the opportunity to gain a feel for how to create interactive media products and create pre-production documents. The latter skill then ties in very well with the examined unit that students will sit in May/June exam period of year 10. Dependent on the student's result in year 10, they do then have the option to re-sit this exam in year 11, effectively giving students 2 chances to get their best result.

What will you have to do in Year 11?

Year 11 will be spent completing the remaining two units of coursework. As mentioned above, students have the option to re-sit the examined unit but can also re-sit the non-examined unit. However, all re-sits must be prepared for in the student's own time.

Home study Plan

Students will be given homework made up of past paper questions to help them prepare for their written examination.
